


The Annual Catholic Appeal funds 43 ministries and agencies within the Diocese of Springfield. In some cases, it is the sole source of funds for these ministries.

CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

Catholic education is the largest recipient of ACA dollars funding educational support to elementary and high school students. Enrollment is growing as in-person learning is possible even with COVID-19 restrictions. THE GRAY HOUSE

Founded by the Sisters of St. Joseph 35 years ago, The Gray House in Springfield's north end continues to be a neighbor, helping neighbors. Moving to contactless curbside food distribution, the staff and volunteers responded to the COVID-19 related 132% increase in demand for help. Remote and onsite tutoring and adult education and educational support for children continue with safety measures in place. Most recently providing winter coats, turkey dinners, and Christmas gifts for families with children the goal is to adapt to the ever changing needs of the low income neighbors in the North End.



RICK'S PLACE

Providing emotional care to grieving children and their families, Rick's Place continues its mission of free support programs even as COVID-19 prevents in person meetings. Dealing with the death of a parent, grandparent, a sibling, or a friend is difficult and made even more challenging when opportunities to mourn are stymied. Now using virtual groups to work with schools to help students on their grief journey, Rick's Place continues its ten year mission in memory of Rick Thorpe of Wilbraham who died on 9/11.

Here families with special needs are embraced and supported. People with additional needs are integrated into the life of the Church and faith community as the barriers for full inclusion are removed.
